It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of AgriEuro Corp. (“EURI”) because of concerns regarding the accuracy and adequacy of information in the marketplace and potentially manipulative transactions in EURI’s common stock. EURI is a Nevada corporation purportedly having its principal executive offices in Romania, and its common stock is quoted on the OTC Link, LLC operated by OTC Market’s Group, Inc. under the ticker symbol EURI.

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed company.

Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed company is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on April 4, 2017 through 11:59 p.m. EDT on April 18, 2017.
