**ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF
TRADING**

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of dELiA*s Inc. (CIK No. 1337885), a forfeited Delaware corporation with its principal place of business listed as New York, New York with stock quoted on OTC Link (previously, “Pink Sheets”) operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc. (“OTC Link”) under the ticker symbol DLIAQ, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended August 2, 2014. On March 24, 2017, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to dELiA*s Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, and dELiA*s Inc. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of Global Energy, Inc. (CIK No. 1090967), a Nevada corporation with its principal place of business listed as Ramat Gan, Israel with stock quoted on OTC Link under the ticker symbol GEYI, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended June 30, 2014. On December 29, 2016, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to Global Energy, Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, and Global Energy, Inc. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed companies.

Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed companies is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on June 21, 2017, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on July 5, 2017.
