CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES PHILLIP ELLIOTT ORDERED TO DISGORGE \$1 MILLION

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on August 29 U.S. District Judge William M. Hoever, Southern District of Florida, entered an order directing Charles Phillip Elliott, of Naples, Florida, to disgorge \$1 million to the receiver of the Court. Elliott was formerly the sole proprietor of Elliott, doing business as Elliott Enterprises, an unincorporated business with offices in Fort Myers and Naples, Florida.

The Court previously entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction, Appointment of Receiver, and Other Relief which permanently enjoins Elliott and the entities under his control from further violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws.

The March 31, 1987 Complaint alleges that Elliott, Elliott Enterprises, and Elliott Mortgage Company, Inc., among other things, sold unregistered securities, operated an unregistered broker-dealer, and obtained funds from investors by misrepresenting and omitting material facts regarding the investments. (SEC v. Charles Phillip Elliott, et al., Civil Action No. 87-12012-CIV-HOEVELER, SDFL). (LR-11867)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JAMES ATTARIAN AND RICHARD PLACHE CONVICTED; OTHERS PLEAD GUILTY

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of California announced that a federal jury found James Attarian guilty of 36 counts of mail fraud and 11 counts of selling unregistered securities and Richard Plache guilty of 15 counts of mail fraud and 3 counts of selling unregistered securities in connection with the purchase and sale of the securities of Elmas Mining Corporation and Republic Overseas Bank, Ltd. (ROBL). Attarian was a director and managing officer of Elmas and controlled the business activities of ROBL. Plache was a senior sales person and member of the Elmas Advisory Council.

Others named in the original indictment were: Gordon De Leon, a senior sales person and Advisory Council member, who pled guilty to two counts of selling unregistered securities; Russell B. Smith, an attorney for Elmas, who pled guilty to one count of selling unregistered securities and one count of mail fraud; and Donald Smith, a director and managing officer of Elmas, who pled guilty to one count of selling unregistered securities and one count of mail fraud. Sentencing will take place in late September. (U.S. v. James Attarian, et al., EDCA, CR No. S-87-164-LKK). (LR-11866)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, The Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Utilities Service Company (NUSCO), The Rocky River Realty Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO), Western Massachusetts Electric Company, The Quinnehtuk Company, and Holyoke Water Power Company, for Northeast to borrow funds from external sources through December 31, 1988 in an amount of up to \$60 million, as

previously authorized by order dated December 24, 1986 [Rel. 35-24282], for the additional purpose of providing these funds through the Northeast System Money Pool to certain Money Pool participants. The only recipients of such external borrowings by Northeast will be NUSCO, NNECO, Rocky River, and Quinnehtuk. (Rel. 35-24715 - Sept. 15)

PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Pennsylvania Electric Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, through December 31, 1997, to lease certain real property and all or unused portions of buildings which it owns in Western Pennsylvania to nonaffiliate third parties for rentals ranging from \$1 to \$2,400 annually and for terms of up to 25 years. UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges (UTP) in the common stock of three over-the-counter (OTC) issues, Amgen, Inc., L.A. Gear, Inc., and Blockbuster Entertainment Corp., and granting the MSE's application to withdraw UTP in the common stock of three OTC issues, Cetus Corp., Daisy Systems Corp., and Wyse Technology. UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 11 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in four issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-25) to amend Sections 21 and 24 of its Code of Arbitration Procedure to give its Director of Arbitration authority to fill any vacancy on an arbitration panel that occurs prior to or after commencement of a hearing session.
