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COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES AND

LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL RELEASED

EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Commission today released a legislative proposal, the "International Securities Enforcement Cooperation Act of 1989," transmitted to the Honorable Donald W. Riegle, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs, yesterday. If enacted, it would give the Commission statutory authority to maintain confidentiality of certain evidence provided by foreign authorities, would make explicit the Commission's rulemaking authority to provide documents to foreign authorities, and authorize the Commission to accept the findings of foreign jurisdictions in determining bars or suspensions from the securities business. Its provisions are similar to those in the "International Securities Enforcement Cooperation Act of 1988," with the exception of a provision authorizing the Commission to exercise enforcement authority in the U.S. on behalf of foreign jurisdictions, which was enacted into law as part of the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988.

Two new provisions in the current package would give self-regulatory organizations the authority to exclude convicted felons from membership, and authorize the Commission to accept reimbursement from foreign authorities for expenses incurred on their behalf.

SIPC FILES COMPLAINT AND APPLICATION

The New York Regional Office announced that on February 28 the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC) filed a Complaint and Application in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York against Investors Center, Inc., a registered penny stock broker-dealer headquartered in Hauppauge, New York, requesting the issuance of a protective decree and appointment of a trustee under the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970. SIPC alleged, in its Application, that Investors Center is unable to meet its obligations to its customers and is in violation of the net capital rules of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Irving Picard, Esq. of the law firm Olshan, Grundman & Frome was appointed temporary receiver for Investors Center, pending a determination of SIPC's Complaint and Application. (SIPC v. Investors Center, Inc., Civil Action No. 89-0666, EDNY).

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

APPLICATION-DECLARATION OF CSW CREDIT INC. AND CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION GRANTED

Chief Administrative Law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision granting the application-declaration of Central and South West Corporation, a registered public utility holding company, and of CSW Credit, its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary.

Judge Blair found that the granting of the application-declaration which sought authorization for expansion of CSW Credit's business of factoring accounts receivable of CSW operating subsidiaries and of nonassociate electric utilities would not be detrimental to the carrying out of the provisions of Section 11(b)(1) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST PREDATOR AUTOMOTIVE CONCEPTS, INC., OTHERS

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on February 8 and 13 the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of California entered Final Judgments permanently enjoining Predator Automotive Concepts, Inc., San Joaquin Investment Club, Vernon T. Mullican, and Russell C. Gray from violating the registration, antifraud, and broker registration provisions of the securities laws. Defendants consented to the injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The Complaint alleged, among other things, that defendants variously sold interests in a nonexistent company; falsely represented that Predator would make a registered offering of its stock in the near future; sold Predator stock at different prices on the same day without disclosing this to investors; failed to disclose that the company was on the verge of bankruptcy; misrepresented the existence of collateral for loans made to the corporation; and misrepresented the status of a \$10 million contract and other business activities. (SEC v. Predator Automotive Concepts, Inc., et al., USDC EDCA, Civil Action No. 88-255, EDP). (LR-12014)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CRIMINAL CONTEMPT SHOW CAUSE ORDER ISSUED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on February 15 U.S. District Court Judge Robert B. Maloney, Northern District of Texas, entered a Notice and Order to Show Cause why George R. Carter, Douglas Litchfield, and Walter R. Mooney, all of Las Vegas, Nevada, should not be held in criminal contempt. The criminal contempt action arises out of a pending civil injunctive action [SEC v. Oreo Mines, Inc., et al] in which Judge Maloney had previously entered Orders Appointing Receiver Pendente Lite for two defendant corporations. The receivership orders specifically enjoined all persons from prosecuting any actions which involve the receiver, or which affect the property of defendants, except in Judge Maloney's court. The show cause order states that probable cause exists for believing that Carter, Litchfield, and Mooney knowingly and willfully violated the Court's receivership orders by filing, and aiding and abetting others in the filing of, involuntary bankruptcy petitions against the two corporations in receivership. A hearing on the criminal contempt matter is scheduled for March 8. (U.S. ex rel SEC v. George Carter, et al., CR 3-036-T). (LR-12013)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SECURITY MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION - 1

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by Security Mortgage Acceptance Corporation - 1 and Bear, Stearns & Co. Inc. for an order amending a previous order [Rel. IC-16715, December 28, 1988] to permit the sale of residual interests under the circumstances described in the application. (Rel. JOHN HANCOCK VARIABLE ANNUITY ACCOUNT F

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by John Hancock Variable Annuity Account F seeking an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16838 - Feb. 24)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-88-18) requesting approval of a pilot program for the International Institutional Delivery (IID) System through January 31, 1989. Approval was granted in Release 34-26374 [December 20, 1988, 53 FR 52283]. This order now extends temporary approval of the IID System through March 31, 1989. (Rel. 34-26577)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
