Please disclose how any votes in favor of CEPM's nominees would be treated if the company were to determine that the nominations by CEPM were invalid under the terms of the operating agreement, as described on page 28 of your proxy statement, at or around the time of the meeting. Please also disclose how any votes in favor of CEPM's nominees would be treated if the company were to determine that the nominees did not satisfy the criteria for manager nominees set forth in the company's Corporate Governance Guidelines, as described on page 11.
