I have been engaged as counsel to Alliance Freight Lines Inc. in connection with the preparation and filing of a registration statement on Form 1-A. The registration statement covers the registration under the Securities Act of 1933 of 15,000 notes, Convertible Notes to be sold by Alliance Freight Lines Inc., a Delaware corporation.

In connection with the opinion contained herein, I have examined the registration statement, the articles of incorporation and bylaws, the minutes of meetings of its board of directors, as well as all other documents necessary to render an opinion.
