Youth receive hands-on exposure to a variety of careers and civic engagement that step them outside of their current boundaries. Our target demographics are African American, Latino and Native American males, however, the program is inclusive of all youth. We have almost equal parity of girls that participate in our programs and also youth with special needs. iUrban Teen programs are now in Washington, Oregon, California, Texas and launching in New York in the Fall of June 2016.

OUR GOALS - Creating the Spark:

Increase awareness and knowledge of STEM+C+A, Civic and Communication careers and training.

Build confidence and critical thinking skills

Provide mentoring and internship opportunities.

Create a collaborative learning model for youth to continue to use in various surroundings. Create a personal development plan in an interactive environment

We start the engagement, or what we call iEngage, with all-day tech immersion events where teens discover what's new in the amazing world of technology, gain leadership skills, and exposure to exciting companies.

The next step is our iLearn modules which include our training programs and camps. These are learning excursions that will continue their learning process for STEM+Arts opportunities and deepen their leadership skills.

Our last step on their journey is iSucceed. The skills and knowledge they will learn in this process with mentoring and internship opportunities will not only allow them to better understand the STEM+Arts rich environment—but will also give them the ability to help shape their world in a creative way.
