On May 9, 2008, Cleco Corporation (the "Company") announced that Kathleen Nolen, senior vice president and chief financial officer of the Company and its wholly owned subsidiary Cleco Power LLC ("Cleco Power"), is leaving the Company and Cleco Power effective May 31, 2008. Russell Davis, vice president and chief accounting officer of the Company and Cleco Power, will serve as interim chief financial officer. On May 7, 2008, Ms. Nolen notified the Company and Cleco Power of her decision to leave. Ms. Nolen is leaving the Company to join the staff of The Rapides Foundation, a \$230 million endowed charitable foundation devoted to improving the health status of central Louisiana.
