Please note that the first clause in the last sentence of our comment requested information about any contacts with Syria, Sudan and Cuba. Please clarify whether you have past, current or anticipated contacts with non-government persons or entities in Syria, Sudan or Cuba, including through the provision of insurance of cargoes and vessels, and if so, please provide the information requested in our comments.
