We continue to believe that you should not use "operating profit" as the starting point for calculating cash provided by operating activities in your statement of cash flows. We believe that your presentation results in the exclusion of reconciling items that are useful in understanding the relationship between profit and loss and cash flows from operating activities. Please revise your presentation in future filings.
