ORDER TO SHOW
CAUSE

On December 23, 2015, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. A telephonic prehearing conference is scheduled for January 26, 2016.

Respondent was served with the OIP on December 28, 2015, and its answer was due by January 7, 2016. *Yayi Int'l, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 3468, 2016 SEC LEXIS 24 (Jan. 5, 2016). To date, Respondent has not filed an answer.

Accordingly, I ORDER that by January 19, 2016, Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. *See* 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). If Respondent fails to respond to this order, it will be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 2-3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f). The prehearing conference will take place on January 26, 2016, as scheduled.
