ORDER POSTPONING HEARING

On July 19, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings. The Division of Enforcement filed a declaration of service, as well as an amended and updated declaration of service, on July 29 and August 2, respectively. These declarations indicate that the OIP was served on Respondents, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) and (iv), by July 29, 2016. Respondents' answers are therefore due by August 11, 2016. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

The August 8, 2016, hearing in this matter is POSTPONED. I ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference shall occur on August 11, 2016, at 3:30 p.m. Eastern.
