On August 31, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.¹

I previously found that Respondents were served with the OIP by September 8 and their answers were due by September 21, 2016. *Multi-Corp. Int'l, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4178, 2016 SEC LEXIS 3528 (ALJ Sept. 19, 2016). To date, Respondents have not filed answers.

Accordingly, Respondents are ORDERED to SHOW CAUSE by October 3, 2016, why the registrations of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend the proceeding. If Respondents fail to respond to this order, they will be deemed in default and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
