## Dear Ms. Murphy:

Under Section 14 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 we respectfully submit public comment to the Members of the Securities & Exchange Commission requesting they develop rules to require public companies to disclose to shareholders the use of corporate resources for political activities.

Therefore we urge the Commission require the reporting of these donations & that all be posted to the SEC website in the shortest possible timeframe.
