On Monday, January 24, 2022, representatives of the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") participated in a meeting with representatives of Donnelley Financial Solutions, Inc. ("DFIN"), which had previously submitted comment letters to the SEC in response to the Request for Comment on Potential Technical Changes to EDGAR Filer Access and Filer Account Management Processes.¹ The SEC representatives were Jed Hickman, Rosemary Filou, Daniel Winter, and Daniel Chang, of the EDGAR Business Office, with relevant SEC contractors also in attendance.
