RE: Meeting with Representatives of Confluence Technologies, Inc.

On Monday, April 4, 2022, representatives of the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”) participated in a meeting with representatives of Confluence Technologies, Inc. (“Confluence”), which had previously submitted a comment letter to the SEC in response to the Request for Comment on Potential Technical Changes to EDGAR Filer Access and Filer Account Management Processes.¹ The SEC representatives were Jed Hickman, Rosemary Filou, Margie Marrero, Daniel Winter, and Daniel Chang (all from the EDGAR Business Office), with relevant SEC contractors also in attendance. The Confluence representatives included Grace Amond, Sagar Thakur, David Le, Matt Lowes, and Matt Stewart.

The meeting was held as part of the staff’s efforts to seek additional information and engage in a dialogue regarding the concerns raised by commenters in response to the Commission’s Request for Comment, pursuant to the Chair’s request that the staff consider how the agency might address concerns articulated by commenters. The participants discussed the EDGAR Next project, including EDGAR filer access and filer account management processes.
