These Proposed Regulations, we are told, will require the commissioners, trustees, directors and officers of county and municipal entities, and their instrumentalities, to be “permitted” by *both* the SEC and the MSRB to continue in their appointed posts after paying a \$600 fee and completing the proposed 73 page form “MA,” perhaps annually.

Kindly declare in clear, firm terms that the natural persons who give their time and service as commissioners, trustees, directors and officers of said county and municipal entities and their instrumentalities (such as port, river, water, air, road, bridge and drainage authorities) are indeed the Municipal Advisees, and *not* the Advisors.
