BTW, I encourage SEC to consider:

- a) challenging publicly traded companies to voluntarily publish their corporate social responsibility (CSR) plans and reports on the Web in open, standard, machine-readable StratML format;
- b) establishing a national/international competition to recognize those who are judged by the public as being the best corporate citizens, based upon the information contained in their CSR reports; and
- c) exploring potentials to reduce regulatory burdens in trade for more open, comprehensive, and standardized CSR reporting and **stakeholder feedback** – via StratML-enabled ***business*** (as opposed to “social”) networking services.
