SR-ICC-2018-008; Partial Amendment No. 1

ICE Clear Credit LLC ("ICC") is filing this Partial Amendment No. 1 to SR-ICC-2018-008 (the "Filing"). ICC submits this Partial Amendment No. 1 in order to provide the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission") with additional details and analyses surrounding ICC's proposed transition from a stress-based approach to a Monte Carlo-based methodology for certain components of the Initial Margin ("IM") model. This Partial Amendment No. 1 includes additional information, which is herein submitted as Exhibit 3, related to the Filing. ICC amends the "Filing" as follows:

- 1. ICC proposes to add the following text directly below the first sentence under the "Exhibits" heading on page 23 of the Form 19b-4 (new text <u>underlined</u>):
 - Exhibit 3 A correlation sensitivity analysis using the proposed Monte Carlobased methodology and a back-testing analysis of the Initial Margin components of the proposed Monte Carlo-based methodology is included. Omitted and filed separately with the Commission. Confidential treatment of this Exhibit 3 pursuant to 17 CFR 240.24b-2 is being requested.

ICC submits Exhibit 3, which has been redacted in its entirety and filed separately with the Commission. Exhibit 3 contains a correlation sensitivity analysis on portfolios using the proposed Monte Carlo-based methodology for the first half of 2018 and a backtesting analysis of the IM components of the proposed Monte Carlo-based methodology spanning 2015 through 2018 and including periods of stressed market conditions. As noted above, ICC submits this Partial Amendment No. 1 to provide the Commission with further information relating to the Filing to facilitate its review. All other representations in the Filing remain unchanged as stated therein and no other changes are being made.
