I am writing the commission in response to the NYSE proposal to revise the transaction fees on the New York Stock Exchange. I strongly urge you not to approve this proposal.

I have been an independent floor broker on the NYSE for 33 years. I currently have 2 employees working with me. My firm executes trades for varying types of customers (buy-side, sell-side, non-member broker dealers, pension funds, etc.).

If this new fee proposal is approved, my transaction cost will increase by 138.9, %(or if you want, by 52.00). This increase will put my firm in financial peril and very well might force me out of business altogether.

I have been providing a valuable service to my customers for $\underline{33}$ years and want to continue to do so. Do not let the NYSE force me out of business because of an unevenly applied and arbitrary pricing structure.
