I am opposed to the creation of any NAC which includes federal or state managed public lands. These lands were set aside and designated for public use and enjoyment. These lands hold our natural resources -water, agriculture, timber, minerals, and clean air. Control by publicly traded companies or foreign interests will not result in management beneficial to our public use and enjoyment, but will be sold to the highest bidder, including foreign investors, who do not have the same purpose in mind. This could potentially eliminate all grazing rights, impact water rights, restrict enjoyment of clean air, result in timber clear cutting for foreign sale, and eliminate extraction of minerals or oil and gas, just to name a few.

I am not in favor of this proposal and I urge the SEC to reject the inclusion of any state or federal public lands in any NAC.
