

## Re: Yavapai Cattle Growers Association Opposition to the SEC Proposed Rules for Natural Asset Companies

To Whom it May Concern:

The Yavapai Cattle Growers Association (YCGA) of Yavapai County, Arizona stand adamantly opposed to the "SEC Proposed Rule for Natural Asset Companies".

The proposed NAC undermines the constitutional and the property rights of individuals in the name of the public good.
