SR-NYSEArca-2016-143; Partial Amendment No. 1

NYSE Arca, Inc. (“NYSE Arca” or the “Exchange”) hereby amends SR-NYSEArca-2016-143 (the “Filing”) as follows:

1. The Exchange proposes to replace footnote 10 on page 5 of the Form 19b-4 and page 10 of Exhibit 1 of the Filing with the following:

“OTPs would be required to provide all the essential information regarding the QCC Order when sending it to NYSE OptX, including the price of the option and the stock, the size and side of the order, i.e., buy or sell, and delta. The Exchange represents that QCC Orders sent to the Exchange for execution would comply with the order format and EOC entry requirements established by the Exchange. See Rule 6.67 – Order Format and System Entry Requirements.”

All other representations in the Filing remain unchanged as stated therein and no other changes are being made.
