SR-NYSEArca-2017-05; Amendment No. 3

NYSE Arca, Inc. (“Exchange”) hereby amends SR-NYSEArca-2017-05 (the “Filing”) as follows:

- 1. The Exchange proposes to add a new footnote 11 at the end of the first sentence in the second full paragraph on page 6 of the Filing (a new footnote 12 at the end of the first sentence of the second full paragraph on page 23 of the Exhibit 1).**

A new footnote would be added at the end of the first sentence of the second full paragraph under the heading titled “Investment Strategies of the Funds” on page 6 of the Filing (first full paragraph under the heading titled “Investment Strategies of the Funds” on page 23 of the Exhibit 1) that would read as follows (new text underlined):

^{11/12} The oil contract market is of significant size and liquidity, and has average daily volume of 650,000 contracts and daily open interest of 450,000 contracts.

All other representations in the Filing remain as stated therein and no other changes are being made.
