SR-NYSEArca-2018-74, Partial Amendment No. 1

NYSE Arca, Inc. (the “Exchange”) hereby submits this partial amendment to SR-NYSEArca-2018-74 (the “Filing”) in connection with its proposal to adopt new order types and quotation designations.

1. The Exchange proposes the following amendments to Exhibit 5 of the Filing (at pp. 55-56), but notes that for changes in the original Filing new text is underscored and deleted text is bracketed, whereas for changes made pursuant to the first partial amendment below, new text is italicized in bold and deleted text is struck-through:

Rule 6.37A-O. Market Maker Quotations — OX

(3) A Market Maker may designate a quote as follows:

(B) Market Maker - Add Liquidity Only Quotation (“MMALO”). Neither an arriving nor resting quotation designated MMALO will trade as the liquidity taker or display at a price that locks or crosses any interest on the Exchange or the NBBO. Instead of trading, an MMALO will be repriced as provided for in Rule 6.37BA-O(a)(4)(A). A MMALO will be rejected if entered outside of Core Trading Hours or during a trading halt.

(C) Market Maker - Repricing Quotation (“MMRP”). Neither an arriving nor resting quotation designated MMRP will display at a price that locks or crosses the NBBO. An MMRP will be repriced as provided for in Rule 6.37BA-O(a)(4)(B).

Additionally, the Exchange requests the Commission to find good cause to grant accelerated approval of NYSEArca-2018-74, as amended, pursuant to Section 19(b)(2) of the Act. The Exchange’s Filing to adopt new order types and quotation designations was published in the Federal Register on October 24, 2018 and, as of the date of this Amendment No. 1, no comments regarding the original Filing were submitted. Accelerated approval would allow the Exchange to implement, without delay, the proposed technical modifications (to correct two typographical errors) at the same time that the Filing goes into effect, which would not only provide additional clarity and reduce any potential ambiguity regarding the proposed quotation designations, accelerated approval would also enable the Exchange to compete with options exchanges that already offer order types and quote designations similar to those proposed in the Filing.
