SR-NYSEMKT-2017-16; Partial Amendment No. 1

NYSE MKT LLC ("NYSE MKT" or the "Exchange") hereby amends SR-NYSEMKT- 2017-16 (the "Filing") as follows:

1. The Exchange proposes to add the following text directly below the first partial paragraph on page 4 of the Form 19b-4 above the heading titled "Background" and directly below the first full paragraph on page 18 of the Exhibit 1 of the Filing under the "Purpose" heading (new text underlined):

"The Exchange will announce via Regulatory Bulletin the operative date of this rule filing at least 30 days prior to the operative date. The Rule will be operative no later than 90 days from the date the rule filing is approved by the Commission. The current version of Rule 36 will remain in effect until the operative date of amended Rule 36. All Exchange-provided cell phones will be disabled as of the operative date of amended Rule 36. The Exchange will announce via Regulatory Bulletin the date through which the current version of Rule 36 will remain operative and when the amended version of the Rule will become operative.

In order for the Exchange's rulebook to reflect the date through which the current version of Rule 36 will remain operative and when the amended version of the Rule will become operative, the Exchange proposes to add the following legend above the current version of Rule 36:

This version of Rule 36 will remain operative until the amended version of Rule 36 becomes operative on a date to be announced by the Exchange via Regulatory Bulletin at least 30 days in advance of the implementation date. The implementation date will not be later than October 4, 2017.

The Exchange further proposes to add the following legend above the amended version of Rule 36:

This version of Rule 36 will become operative on a date to be announced by the Exchange via Regulatory Bulletin at least 30 days in advance of the implementation date. The implementation date will not be later than October 4, 2017."

All other representations in the Filing remain unchanged as stated therein and no other changes are being made.
