STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED] ORDER FOR VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL AS TO DEFENDANT UNITED GULF BANK

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC"), and Defendant United Gulf Bank (B.S.C.) Plaintiff SEC and Defendant UGB also stipulate that each is to bear its own costs.

Defendant UGB hereby waives any and all claims to seek from the United States, or any agency, or any official of the United States acting in his or her official capacity, directly or indirectly, reimbursement of attorney's fees or other fees, expenses, or costs expended by or on behalf of Defendant UGB to defend against this action.
