This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for an Order Directing a Second Disbursement of the Fair Fund and Release of the Fee Holdback. Having considered the Motion, the Declaration of the Distribution Agent, and the record in this case, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, for good cause shown the Motion is **GRANTED**. The Court **HEREBY ORDERS AND ADJUDGES** as follows:

- 1. The Distribution Agent is directed to:
 - Implement a second distribution of the funds remaining in the Fair
 Fund, less a reserve as established below, to those Eligible
 Claimants who cashed their checks from the initial or supplemental
 disbursements, pursuant to the Final Payee List for the Second
 Distribution reviewed and accepted by Commission staff; and
 - b. Establish a reserve from the Fair Fund for any remaining taxes, related fees and expenses of the Tax Administrator, and fees and expenses of the Distribution Agent, to be paid upon written direction and approval of the Commission staff, without further order from the Court.
- 2. Further, the Court authorizes the release to the Distribution Agent of the 10% Fee Holdback from Commission-approved invoices for the services provided through September 30, 2019.
