**SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION'S MOTION FOR AN ORDER  
APPROVING THE FINAL ACCOUNTING, DISCHARGING THE DISTRIBUTION  
AGENT, AND RELATED RELIEF**

The SEC respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order approving the final accounting attached to the Memorandum as Exhibit A; directing the SEC to remit all funds remaining in the Distribution Fund after payment of the Tax Administrator, and any funds returned to the Distribution Fund in the future, to the SEC for remittance to the general fund of the U.S. Treasury, subject to Section 21F(g)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [15 U.S. Code § 78u-6(g)(3)]; and discharging the Distribution Agent.

In accordance with Local Rule 7.1(a)(2), the SEC staff has contacted Jeffrey A. Denner, Esq., counsel for defendant Jones, regarding the relief sought in this Motion. Mr. Denner has informed the SEC staff that he has no objection to this motion.

**WHEREFORE**, for all the reasons set forth in the Memorandum and exhibit thereto, the SEC respectfully requests that this Court enter the proposed Order and grant such other relief as it deems just and proper.
