This letter responds to your request, dated April 25, 2018 and received in this office on April 25, 2018, for records of any consumer complaints, civil actions, investigations and/or any disciplinary actions concerning Paul Thomas Tracy.

Consumer Complaints

Based on the information you provided in your letter, we conducted a search of the SEC's consumer complaints systems of records, but did not locate any records responsive to your request. If you still have reason to believe that the SEC maintains the records you seek, please provide us with additional information, which could prompt another search. Otherwise, we conclude we have no responsive records to this portion of your request.

Investigations

We can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any records responsive to your request. If such records were to exist, they would be exempt from disclosure pursuant to FOIA Exemptions 6 and/or (7)(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) and (7)(C), 17 CFR § 200.80(b)(6) and (7)(iii). Under Exemption 6 the release of this type of information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Under Exemption 7(C) release of such information could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. By outlining the provisions of these exemptions, we do not mean to imply in any way that records responsive to your request exist.
