IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Newman is assessed, and shall pay to the Commission for delivery to the United States Treasury, a civil penalty in the āmount of \$30,000 under the Securities Enforcement and Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77t(d)] and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. § 78(d)(3)]. Newman shall pay the above penalty within 30 days of entry of this Judgment. This payment shall be made by cashier's check, certified check or postal money order, payable to the United States Treasury, and shall be transmitted to the Comptroller, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Stop 0-3, Alexandria, VA 22312, under cover of a letter which identifies the defendant, the name and case number of this litigation and the name of the
