ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION'S MOTION TO MODIFY THE FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT PANAYIOTIS PAPASERAPHIM

On September 11, 2002, Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission filed a Motion to Modify the Final Judgment as to Defendant Panayiotis Papaseraphim (entered by this Court on August 16, 2002) to require Papaseraphim to pay his disgorgement, pre-judgment interest



thereon, and civil penalty into the Registry of the Court, rather than to the U.S. Treasury as specified in the original Final Judgment. This motion is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Final Judgment as to Defendant Panayiotis Papaseraphim, entered by this Court on August 16, 2002, is modified to now require that defendant Papaseraphim shall pay his disgorgement, pre-judgment interest thereon, and civil penalty obligation, a total of \$11,113 (US), to the Registry of the Court, pending further Order of this Court.
