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- 3. On December 16, 2002, Eisenberg was sentenced to, among other things, 63 months imprisonment and ordered to pay \$12,736,118 in restitution in United States of America v. Gary A. Eisenberg, CR 02-897-R.
- 4. In light of the sentence in the criminal case, the Commission has determined not to pursue its remaining claims for disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties against Eisenberg.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED between the Commission and Eisenberg, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2), that the Commission's remaining claims against Eisenberg for disgorgement, prejudgment interest thereon, and civil penalties be, and hereby are, dismissed against Eisenberg.
