# FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT JAMES PROFFITT

The Securities and Exchange Commission having filed a Complaint and James Proffitt ("Proffitt" or "Defendant") having entered a general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this Final Judgment w thout admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint (except as to jurisdiction) waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; and waived any right to appeal from this Final Judgment:

It is Hereby Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant and Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, including by facsimile or overnight delivery service, are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [15 U.S.C. § 78j(b)] and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder [17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5], by using any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security:

- (a) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud;
- (b) to make any untrue statement of a material fact or to omit to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or
- (c) to engage in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person in connection with the purchase or sale of securities.

## II.

It Is Hereby Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant and Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, including by facsimile or overnight delivery service, are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 [15 U.S.C. § 77q(a)], directly

or indirectly, in the offer or sale of any securities by the use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce, or by the use of the mails:

- (a) to employ any device, scheme or artifice to defraud;
- (b) to obtain any money or property by means of any untrue statement of a material fact or any omission to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or
- (c) to engage in any transaction, practice, or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon the purchaser of securities.

#### III.

It Is Hereby Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant and Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, including by facsimile or overnight delivery service, are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 [15 U.S.C. §§ 77e(a) and (c)] by, directly or indirectly, in the absence of any applicable exemption:

- (a) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to sell such security through the use or medium of a prospectus or otherwise;
- (b) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, carrying or causing to be carried through the mails or in interstate commerce, by any means or

- instruments of transportation, any security for the purpose of sale or for delivery after sale; or
- (c) Making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to offer to sell or offer to buy through the use or medium of a prospectus or otherwise, any security, unless a registration statement has been filed as to such security, or while a registration statement as to such security is the subject of a refusal order or stop order or (prior to the effective date of the registration statement) any public proceeding or examination under Section 8 of the Securities Act of 1933 [15 U.S.C. § 77h].

#### IV

It Is Hereby Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that Defendant and Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise, including by facsimile or overnight delivery service, are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Section 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [15 U.S.C. § 78o(a)] by, directly or indirectly, effecting securities transactions for the account of others or engaging in business as a dealer without being registered as a broker-dealer or being associated with a registered broker-dealer for purposes of those transactions or that business.

#### W

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is liable for disgorgement of \$232,967, representing ill-gotten gains obtained as a result of the conduct

alleged in the Commission's Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$74,406, for a total of \$307,373. However, based on Defendant's sworn representations in his Statement of Financial Condition dated June 10, 2005 and his affidavit dated April 21, 2006, and other documents and information submitted to the Commission, the Court is not ordering Defendant to pay a civil penalty and payment of all but \$20,000 of the disgorgement and pre-judgment interest thereon is waived. The determination not to impose a civil penalty and to waive payment of all but \$20,000 of the disgorgement and pre-judgment interest the eon is contingent upon the accuracy and completeness of Defendant's Statement of Financial Condition and other documents submitted by him to the Commission. If at any time following the entry of this Final Judgment the Commission obtains information indicating that Defendant's representations to the Commission concerning his assets, income, liabilities, or net worth were fraudulent, misleading, inaccurate, or incomplete in any material respect as of the time such representations were made, the Commission may, at its sole discretion and without prior notice to Defendant, petition the Court for an order requiring Defendant to pay the unpaid portion of the disgorgement, pre-judgment and post-judgment interest thereon, and the maximum civil penalty allowable under the law. In connection with any such petition, the only issue shall be whether the financial information provided by Defendant was fraudulent, misleading, inaccurate, or incomplete in any material respect as of the time such representations were made. In its petition, the Commission may move this Court to consider all available remedies, including, but not limited to, ordering Defendant to pay funds or assets, directing the forfeiture of any assets, or sanctions for contempt of this Final Judgment. The Commission may also request additional discovery. Defendant may not, by way of defense to such petition: (1) challenge the

validity of the Consent or this Final Judgment; (2) contest the allegations in the Complaint filed by the Commission; (3) assert that payment of disgorgement, pre-judgment and post-judgment interest or a civil penalty should not be ordered; (4) contest the amount of disgorgement and pre-judgment and post-judgment interest; (5) contest the imposition of the maximum civil penalty allowable under the law; or (6) assert any defense to liability or remedy, including, but not limited to, any statute of limitations defense.

Payment shall be made within ten (10) days of entry of this Final Judgment. Payment under this paragraph shall be made by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Mail Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying James Proffitt as a defendant in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. Defendant shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of such payment and letter to the Commission's counsel in this action. Defendant relinquishes all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in such funds, and no part of the funds shall be returned to Defendant. If the payment is not made within the time allotted, Defendant shall pay post-judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.

### VI.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the

Consent of Defendant James Proffitt is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if

fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

## VII.

It Is Hereby Further Ordered, Adjudged, And Decreed that this Court shall retain jurisciction of this action for all purposes, including the implementation and enforcement of this Fina. Judgment.

# VIII.

There being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Clerk of the Court is hereby ordered and directed to enter this Final Judgment forthwith and without further notice.
