The Court having determined there is no just reason to delay final judgment as to defendants, Mohamad Wael Ibrahim Elzein[individually, and d/b/a Focus Mentors Elzein Management] and Hussein Hassan El Zein

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Securities and Exchange Commission recover from defendants Mohamad Wael Ibrahim Elzein[individually, and d/b/a Focus Mentors Elzein Management] and Hussein Hassan El Zein, jointly and severally, disgorgement in the amount of Thirty Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$35,000.00) Dollars and prejudgement interest owned jointly and severally by defendants Mohamad Wael Ibrahim Elzein[individually and d/b/a Focus Mentors Elzein Management] and Hussein Hassan El Zein from November 1, 2001, through October 31, 2004, the sum of Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Fifty-Seven and 80/100(\$5,457.80)Dollars [Total amount jointly and severally Forty Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Seven and 80/100(\$40,457.80) dollars].

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission recover of the defendant, Mohamad Wael Ibrahim Elzein, individually, and d/b/a Focus Mentors Elzein Management a civil penalty pursuant to Section 20 (d) of the Securities Act and Section 21 (d)(3) of the Exchange Act, the sum of Ten Thousand(\$10,000.00)Dollars.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission, recover of the defendant, Hussein Hassan El Zein a civil penalty pursuant to Section 20(d)of Securities Act and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, the sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$2,500.00) Dollars.

By order of the Court dated February 19, 2004:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that defendants Mohamad Wael Ibrahim Elzein, [individually, and d/b/a Focus Mentors Elzein Management] and Hussein Hassan El Zein are permanently enjoined from further violations of, among other things, the registration provisions and antifraud provisions of the Federal Securities Act.
