[X] **Decision on the Record.** This action came before the court on the record, The Honorable Matthew J. Perry, Sr., presiding. The issues have been reviewed and the parties having consented to judgment,.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the defendant, Jerry F. Wells, Jr. and defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys and all persons in active concert or participation with them are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating aiding and abetting, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of The Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act") [15 U.S.C. Section 78j(b)] and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder [17 C.F.R. Section 240.10b-5]; Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and 13(b)(2)(B) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Sections 78m(a), 78m(b)(2)(A) and 78m(b)(2)(B) and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder [17 C.F.R. Sections 240.12b-20, 240.13a-1 and 240.13a-13] and from violating Rule 13a-14 thereunder [17 C.F.R. Section 240.13a-14]; Section 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Section 78m(b)(5)] and Rules 13b2-1 and 13b2-2 thereunder [17 C.F.R. Sections 240.13b2-1 and 240.13b2-2].

FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Section 78u(d)(2)]. Defendant is prohibited from acting as an officer or director of any issuer that has a class of securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Section 781] or that is required to file reports pursuant to Section 15 (d) of the Exchange Act [15 U.S.C. Section 78o(d)].
