FINAL JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT KHALED MOHAMMED SHARIF AL SAYED AL HASHEMI

The Securities and Exchange Commission having filed a Complaint, and defendant Khaled Mohammed Sharif Al Sayed Al Hashemi ("Defendant" or "Hashemi") having entered a general appearance; consented to the Court's jurisdiction over Defendant and the subject matter of this action; consented to entry of this Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint (except as to jurisdiction); waived findings of fact and conclusions of law; and waived any right to appeal from this Final Judgment:

J.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant and Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Final Judgment by personal service or otherwise are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating, directly or indirectly, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act") [15 U.S.C. § 78j(b)] and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder [17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5], by using any means or instrumentality of interstate commerce, or of the mails, or of any facility of any national securities exchange, in connection with the purchase or sale of any security:

- (a) to employ any device, scheme, or artifice to defraud;
- (b) to make any untrue statement of a material fact or to omit to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in the light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading; or
- (c) to engage in any act, practice, or course of business which operates or would operate as a fraud or deceit upon any person.

II.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant is liable for disgorgement of \$458,760 representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$9,620, and a civil penalty in the amount of \$406,620 pursuant to Section 21A of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u-1.

Defendant shall hereby relinquish all ownership, control and beneficial interest in \$875,000 in his account at TD Ameritrade ending in 4552, in the name of the Defendant, currently frozen and restrained pursuant to the Court Order dated September 2, 2009; and upon receipt of this Final Judgment, TD Ameritrade shall pay \$875,000 from Defendant's account at TD Ameritrade ending in 4552 by check payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission.

The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, Operations Center, 6432 General Green Way, Mail Stop 0-3, Alexandria, Virginia 22312, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying Khaled Mohammed Sharif Al Sayed Al Hashemi as a defendant in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. A copy of the foregoing letter, with a copy of the check, shall be simultaneously transmitted to the Commission's counsel in this matter, Catherine E. Pappas, Senior Trial Counsel, Securities and Exchange Commission, 701 Market Street, Suite 2000, Philadelphia, PA 19106. The Commission shall remit the funds paid pursuant to this paragraph to the United States Treasury.

Any funds in the Ameritrade Account in excess of \$875,000 shall be remitted by Ameritrade to Defendant after the timely distribution to, and receipt by, the Securities and Exchange Commission of the \$875,000 payment described in this Paragraph. No part of the funds paid to the Securities and Exchange Commission under this Paragraph II. shall be returned to Defendant, his heirs, successors or assigns.

M.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Consent is incorporated herein with the same force and effect as if fully set forth herein, and that Defendant shall comply with all of the undertakings and agreements set forth therein.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this Final Judgment.
