JUDGMENT AGAINST DOYLE SCOTT ELLIOTT AND SCOTT ELLIOTT INC.

In accordance with the Court's Memorandum Opinion and Order dated August 11, 2011, and findings of facts and conclusions of law contained therein, judgment is entered on the Securities and Exchange Commission's claim that defendants Doyle Scott Elliott ("Elliott") and Scott Elliott Inc. violated Section 5 of the Securities Act of 1933, 15 U.S.C. § 77e, in their sales of the securities of Universal Express Inc. The Court finds that there are no factual disputes to be resolved, and the SEC is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. This judgment resolves all of the SEC's claims against Elliott and Scott Elliott Inc. The violations of Section 5 by Elliott and Scott Elliott Inc. are independent of the alleged violations by the other defendants, so entry of a final judgment under Fed. R. C. P. 54(b) is appropriate and there is no just reason for delay of entry of this judgment.

I.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants Elliott and Scott

Elliott Inc., and each of Defendant's agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this Judgment by personal service or otherwise are permanently restrained and enjoined from violating Section 5 of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77e] by, directly or indirectly, in the absence of any applicable exemption:

- (a) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to sell such security through the use or medium of any prospectus or otherwise;
- (b) Unless a registration statement is in effect as to a security, carrying or causing to be carried through the mails or in interstate commerce, by any means or instruments of transportation, any such security for the purpose of sale or for delivery after sale; or
- (c) Making use of any means or instruments of transportation or communication in interstate commerce or of the mails to offer to sell or offer to buy through the use or medium of any prospectus or otherwise any security, unless a registration statement has been filed with the Commission as to such security, or while the registration statement is the subject of a refusal order or stop order or (prior to the effective date of the registration statement) any public proceeding or examination under Section 8 of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77h].

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants Elliott and Scott Elliott Inc. are permanently barred from participating in an offering of penny stock,

including engaging in activities with a broker, dealer, or issuer for purposes of issuing, trading, or inducing or attempting to induce the purchase or sale of any penny stock. A penny stock is any equity security that has a price of less than five dollars, except as provided in Rule 3a51-1 under the Exchange Act [17 C.F.R. § 240.3a51-1].

III.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendants Elliott and Scott Elliott Inc. are liable jointly and severally for disgorgement of \$6,288,367.93 representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon of \$1,419,406.98, and a civil penalty in the amount of \$6,288,367.93 pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act [15 U.S.C. § 77t(d)], for a total of \$13,996,142.84. Defendants shall satisfy this obligation by paying \$13,996,142.84 within 14 days after entry of this Judgment to the Clerk of this Court, by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Office of Financial Management, Securities and Exchange Commission, 100 F Street, NE, Stop 6042, Washington DC 20549, and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying Elliott and Scott Elliott Inc. as defendants in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Judgment. Defendant shall pay post-judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961. The Commission shall remit the funds paid pursuant to this paragraph to the United States Treasury.

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for purposes of enforcing the terms of this Judgment.

٧.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there being no just reason for delay, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Clerk is to enter this Judgment forthwith and without further notice.
