# ORDER APPOINTING A DISTRIBUTION AGENT; APPOINTING A TAX ADMINISTRATOR; AND DETERMINING AMOUNT OF DISGORGEMENT AND PREJUDGMENT INTEREST

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2009, the Court entered the Final Judgment as to Defendants Gen-See Capital Corporation a/k/a Gen Unlimited and Richard S. Piccoli (the "Final Judgment"), which provides for the transfer of Defendants' assets to the Court's Registry Fund, and further provides that the Commission may by motion propose a plan to distribute the funds in the Registry Fund subject to the Court's approval;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Court's Orders entered June 26, 2009, and November 16, 2009, a total of \$6,249,496.06 has been paid into the Registry Fund, plus the accumulated interest thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Court, having reviewed the brief in support of plaintiff's unopposed motion for an order appointing a distribution agent, appointing a tax administrator, and determining the amount of disgorgement and prejudgment interest,

the Declaration of David Stoelting dated March 25, 2010, and upon all prior proceedings and submissions, and for good cause shown,

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

I.

- A. Pursuant to Paragraph IV of the Final Judgment entered June 9, 2009, defendants Gen-See Capital Corporation a/k/a Gen Unlimited and Richard S. Piccoli are jointly and severally liable for disgorgement of \$26,631,778.48, representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, plus prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$138,654,807.47, for a total of \$165,286,585.95. The total amount of funds previously deposited in the Registry Fund pursuant to the Orders of the Court, \$6,249,496.06, as well as any subsequent payments into the Registry Fund, shall be applied in partial satisfaction of Defendants' disgorgement obligation.

  Accordingly, the remaining balance now owed by Defendants as disgorgement plus prejudgment interest is \$159,037,089.89.
- B. Defendants shall satisfy this obligation by paying \$159,037,089.89 within 14 days after entry of this Order to the Clerk of this Court, together with a cover letter identifying Defendants as defendants in this action; setting forth the title and civil action number of this action and the name of this Court; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Order. Defendants shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of such payment and letter to the Commission's counsel in this action. By making this payment, Defendants relinquish all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in such funds, and

no part of the funds shall be returned to Defendant. The Clerk shall deposit the funds into the Court's Registry Fund.

II.

- A. A.B. Data, Ltd. is appointed Distribution Agent to perform such functions as are necessary to design and implement a plan of distribution to accomplish the distribution of the Registry Fund to the victims of the violations alleged in the Complaint in this case. The plan of distribution, which must be approved by the Court, will provide for the distribution to the victims of monies in the Court's Registry Fund in this case, minus any appropriate expenses incurred in establishing, maintaining, and distributing the Registry Fund, including but not limited to, administrative fees, taxes, or other costs, shall be distributed. The proposed plan shall include the Clerk of this Court preparing the checks to each victim based on information provided by A.B. Data, Ltd., which shall then be sent to A.B. Data, Ltd. by the Clerk of the Court for any further processing and distribution to the victims. The proposed plan of distribution should also incorporate the suggestions of the Commission. The Commission shall file an application seeking an order approving the proposed Plan of Distribution, and the Distribution Agent may join in such an application.
- B. The Court hereby directs the Clerk of the Court, without further order of the Court, to pay fees and expenses from the Registry Fund to A.B. Data in accordance with the schedules attached as Exhibit 1 hereto, upon filing of a notice with the Court by the Commission requesting such payment, provided that the total of all such payments shall not exceed \$35,000. Any amount above \$35,000 shall require Court approval

upon a motion by A.B. Data, and the Commission shall have the right to object to any such motion.

- C. The Distribution Agent may be removed *sua sponte* at any time by the Court or upon motion of the Commission and replaced with a successor. In the event the Distribution Agent decides to resign, it shall first give written notice to the Court and the Commission of its intention, and its resignation, if permitted by the Court, shall not be effective until the Court appoints a successor.
- D. The Distribution Agent shall coordinate with the Court appointed Tax Administrator, Damasco & Associates LLP, to insure that the Registry Fund, a Qualified Settlement Fund ("QSF") under Section 468B(g) of the Internal Revenue Code, and related regulations, 26 C.F.R. §§ 1.468B-1 through 5, complies with all related legal and regulatory requirements, including but not limited to satisfying any reporting or withholding requirements imposed on distributions from the QSF.
- E. The Distribution Agent and the Distribution Agent's designees, agents and assistants are excused from any requirement to post a bond, and shall not be liable to any person for their actions hereunder, except on a finding of misfeasance, gross negligence or reckless disregard of duty.
- F. The Distribution Agent shall file a report with the Court, substantially in the form of the Standardized Fund Accounting Report ("SFAR") attached hereto, within ninety (90) days of its appointment and shall file additional such reports every ninety (90) days thereafter. The Distribution Agent shall file a final report and accounting on

the SFAR when its duties are completed. The Distribution Agent shall serve all its filings on counsel for the Commission and the Defendant.

III.

- A. Damasco & Associates LLP is appointed as Tax Administrator to execute all income tax reporting requirements, including the preparation and filing of tax returns, with respect to the Registry Fund.
- B. Damasco & Associates shall be designated the Tax Administrator of the Fund, pursuant to section 468B(g) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 26 U.S.C. § 468B(g), and related regulations, and shall satisfy the administrative requirements imposed by those regulations, including but not limited to (a) obtaining a federal taxpayer identification number, (b) preparing and filing applicable federal, state, and local tax returns and paying taxes reported thereon out of the Fund, and (c) satisfying any information, reporting, or withholding requirements imposed on distributions from the Fund. The Tax Administrator shall contemporaneously provide copies of all such filings to the Commission's counsel of record.
- C. The Tax Administrator shall, at such times as the Tax Administrator deems necessary to fulfill the tax obligations of the Fund, request that the Commission's counsel of record file with the Court a motion, supported by the Tax Administrator's declaration of the amount of taxes due, to transfer funds from the Fund on deposit with the Court to pay any required tax obligations of the Fund. The Commission may also submit a motion to direct the Clerk of the Court to disburse funds to pay tax obligations.

The Tax Administrator shall be entitled to charge reasonable fees for tax D. compliance services and related expenses in accordance with its agreement with the Commission. The Tax Administrator shall, at such times as the Tax Administrator deems appropriate, submit a declaration of fees and expenses to the Commission's counsel of record for submission to the Court for approval and for payment from the Fund. No fees or expenses may be paid absent the Court's prior approval.

At least ten business (10) days before any motion to pay fees and expenses E. is filed with the Court, the Tax Administrator shall provide the Commission counsel of record with a draft of the supporting declaration for review. If the Commission has any corrections or objections to the declaration, the Tax Administrator and the Commission's counsel shall attempt to resolve them on a consensual basis. If a consensual resolution is not reached, the Commission may submit with the motion any objections along with the Tax Administrator's response thereto.

IV.

The Final Judgment remains fully binding and effective, and this Court shall retain iurisdiction of this matter for all purposes.
