Smanjak are permanently enjoined from further violations of (1) Exchange Act Section 10(b), 15 U.S.C. § 78j(b), Rule 10b-5 thereunder, 17 C.F.R. § 240.10b-5; (2) Securities Act Section 5(a), 15 U.S.C. § 77e(a); (3) Securities Act Section 5(c), 15 U.S.C. § 77e(c); and (4) Securities Act Section 17(a), 15 U.S.C. § 77q(a). It is further ORDERED that Dynkowski and Smanjak are also permanently barred from participating in a pennystock offering, pursuant to Securities Act Section 20(g), 15 U.S.C. § 77t(g), and Exchange Act Section 21(d)(6), 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(6).
