AMENDED ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO SET DISGORGEMENT AMOUNT AS TO DEFENDANT RICHARD P. GREENE

THIS MATTER is before the Court on Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's Motion and Memorandum of Law to Set Disgorgement Amount as to Defendant Richard P. Greene.

This Court previously entered a Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief against Greene. ECF No. 18. The Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction provides that the Court shall determine the amount of disgorgement upon the Commission's motion pursuant to Section 20(d) of the Securities Act, 15 U.S.C. § 77t(d), and Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u(d)(3).

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Motion and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the Motion is **GRANTED**. Richard P. Greene is liable for disgorgement in the amount of \$1,950.00, representing profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint, together with prejudgment interest thereon in the amount of \$114.76.

Greene may transmit payment electronically to the Commission, which will provide detailed ACH transfer/Fedwire instructions upon request. Payment may also be made directly Pay.gov SEC website from a bank account via through the at http://www.sec.gov/about/offices/ofm.htm. Greene may also pay by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission, which shall be delivered or mailed to

and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying the case title, civil action number, and name of this Court; Greene as a Defendant in this action; and specifying that payment is made pursuant to this Final Judgment. Greene shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of evidence of payment and case identifying information to the Commission's counsel in this action. By making this payment, Greene relinquishes all legal and equitable right, title, and interest in such funds and no part of the funds shall be returned to Greene.

The Commission shall hold the funds (collectively, the "Fund") and may propose a plan to distribute the Fund subject to the Court's approval. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over the administration of any distribution of the Fund. If the Commission staff determines that the Fund will not be distributed, the Commission shall send the funds paid pursuant to this Final Judgment to the United States Treasury.

The Commission may enforce the Court's judgment for disgorgement and prejudgment interest, by moving for civil contempt (or through other collection procedures authorized by law) at any time after fourteen days following entry of the Final Judgment. Greene shall pay

post-judgment interest on any delinquent amounts pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
