ORDER POSTPONING HEARING

CHINA ENERGY SAVINGS TECHNOLOGY, INC.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued its Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on September 26, 2006. The Chief Administrative Law Judge then assigned the matter to my docket and scheduled a hearing for October 30, 2006. The record shows that delivery of the OIP was attempted by express mail at China Energy Savings Technology, Inc.'s (China Energy), last known business address in Hong Kong, China, on October 3, 2006. The express mail package was returned unopened on October 19, 2006, and marked "moved, new address unknown."

China Energy is an issuer of securities registered with the Commission. Confirmation of attempted delivery at the most recent address shown on an issuer's most recent filing with the Commission is sufficient notice of a proceeding. See Rule 141(a)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. However, notice of a proceeding to a person in a foreign country also requires proof that the method of service used is not prohibited by the law of the foreign country. The present record contains no evidence that Rule 141(a)(2)(iv) of the Commission's Rules of Practice was satisfied by attempted delivery of an express mail package containing an Englishlanguage document to an abandoned business address in China.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Division of Enforcement shall provide evidence of full compliance with Rule 141(a)(2)(iv) of the Commission's Rules of Practice no later than November 15, 2006; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the hearing scheduled for October 30, 2006, is postponed until December 4, 2006, at the time and place previously identified. The Division of Enforcement's request for a telephonic prehearing conference and the entry of an order of default will be held in abeyance pending proof of full compliance with Rule 141(a)(2)(iv).
