Guy S. Amico (Amico) and Scott H. Goldstein (Goldstein) offered into evidence Respondents' Exhibit 152, a document with eleven numbered pages and two attached exhibits containing another eight unnumbered pages. Respondents obtained the document from the public files of a federal district court proceeding.

Respondents and the Division of Enforcement (Division) then questioned a witness about the document, and I accepted the document into evidence. The Division advised that the record of the district court proceeding was recently sealed at the direction of the presiding judge. The witness, who is the subject of the document, requested that I issue a protective order, barring disclosure of the document, as well as his testimony about the document, to the general public. Counsel for the parties agreed that a protective order is warranted. I find that the harm resulting from disclosure would outweigh the benefits of disclosure.

IT IS ORDERED THAT Respondents' Exhibit 152 and pages 751-760 of the hearing transcript in this matter shall be subject to a protective order. These materials shall be available to counsel for Respondents Amico and Goldstein and the Division, as well as to any Commission decisional officials assigned to the proceeding. However, these materials shall not be available to the general public or to the other Respondents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this protective order shall remain in effect until such time as the federal district court unseals the record in the proceeding on its docket.
