The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued its Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on April 10, 2009. The Division of Enforcement (Division) has been assisting the Office of the Secretary in effectuating service of the OIP. See Rule 141(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

By pleading filed September 2, 2009, the Division has demonstrated that it delivered the OIP to Respondent and obtained a written "waiver of service" from Respondent on August 31, 2009. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the hearing is postponed until November 12, 2009, at the time and place previously announced.
