ORDER POSTPONING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings on July 26, 2013, alleging that Duoyuan Printing, Inc. (Duoyuan Printing), has securities registered with the Commission and has been delinquent in its periodic filings for over two years, and thus has failed to comply with Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Exchange Act Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13.

The proceeding has not gone forward because the Division of Enforcement (Division) is seeking the assistance of authorities in the People's Republic of China to achieve service on Duoyuan Printing. <u>See</u> 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(iv). On March 12, 2014, the Division informed my Office that it had not yet received confirmation from the Chinese Ministry of Justice regarding service. For this reason, I POSTPONE the prehearing conference scheduled for March 19, 2014, to April 22, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. EDT. If the Division accomplishes service on Duoyuan Printing before this date, it should inform my Office.
