POSTPONEMENT ORDER

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on May 9, 2014, pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and a prehearing conference is scheduled for June 27, 2014. The proceeding is a follow-on proceeding based on United States v. Spangler, No. 2:12-cr-133 (W.D. Wash. Mar. 13, 2014), appeal docketed, No. 14-30042 (9th Cir. Mar. 17, 2014), in which Respondent Mark F. Spangler (Spangler) was convicted of wire fraud, money laundering, and investment adviser fraud.

The parties have requested that the due date for Spangler's Answer to the OIP be postponed to June 20, 2014, in light of their discussions of settlement of this proceeding and a pending civil action against Spangler. Consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the requested postponement will be granted, and the due date for Spangler's Answer will be June 20, 2014.
