A prehearing schedule was ordered. *Wedbush Sec., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 1688, 2014 SEC LEXIS 2865 (A.L.J. Aug. 8, 2014). September 11, 2014 Division to identify expert witness[es] and provide and file expert report to be used in lieu of direct testimony;¹

September 18, 2014 Respondents to identify expert witness[es] and provide and file expert report to be used in lieu of direct testimony;

September 22, 2014 Division to identify rebuttal expert, if any; parties to prepare joint exhibit list and joint copy set of all proposed/designated exhibits; and

September 29, 2014 Prehearing briefs to be filed.
