The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) on August 20, 2014. A prehearing conference was scheduled for October 3, 2014. Only Shelron Group, Inc. (Respondent), remains in the proceeding.¹ The OIP alleges that Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. The Division of Enforcement is seeking to revoke the registration of Respondent's securities.

The OIP provides that Respondent's Answer is due within ten days of service of the OIP on it.² See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). A Respondent that fails to file an Answer within the time provided will be deemed to be in default, and the undersigned may enter an order at any time revoking the registration of its securities. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f). Consistent with 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, the prehearing conference will be postponed and held by telephone on November 7, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. EST, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
