ORDER ON MOTIONS

On May 1, 2015, this Office received Respondent's Consent Motion For Leave to Exceed Page Limitations. Respondent requests "leave to file two reply briefs in response to the Division of Enforcement's . . . oppositions to Respondent's two motions for summary disposition that, collectively, will not exceed 28 pages in length." Page Limitations Motion at 1. Respondent represents that the Division indicated that it "would not oppose a reasonable request for a page limit extension." *Id.* In light of Respondent's representations, Respondent's motion is GRANTED.

Also on May 1, 2015, this Office received Respondent's Consent Motion for Extension to File Replacement Redacted Motion for Summary Disposition and Exhibits. On April 22, 2015, I granted Respondent's motion for a protective order in part, and ordered Respondent to file a replacement redacted motion for summary dispositions and exhibits within fourteen days in accord with that order. *Charles L. Hill, Jr.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 2569, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1488, at *12. Respondent requests until May 13, 2015, to file the ordered redactions so that the parties have sufficient time to reach an agreement on stipulations. Extension Motion at 2; *see Charles L. Hill, Jr.*, 2015 SEC LEXIS 1488, at *11-12. Respondent represents that the Division consents to this request. Extension Motion at 2. In light of the fact that the Division consents, Respondent's motion is GRANTED.
