to exhibits and witnesses.

June 8, 2015: Parties shall file any requests for official notice,

stipulations, admissions of fact, and stipulations concerning the contents, authenticity, or admissibility into evidence of documents. Any oppositions to motions in limine and

objections to exhibits and witnesses are due.

June 10, 2015: Parties shall participate in a telephonic prehearing

conference, if necessary, at a time to be determined.

June 15, 2015:	Hearing commences in Atlanta, Georgia.
